## MAISON CERONNE SAINTE-CÉRONNE- LÈS-MORTAGNE

2 hours and 20 minutes from Paris

On a plot of land once occupied by two dilapidated stables, architect Vincent-Louis Voinchet and his partner have now opened Maison Ceronne, a most inspiring design guest-house. They worked on the project for a good four years and everything here comes with a story. They made a lot of the furniture themselves, but the scenic lamps in the kitchen were salvaged from an old theater, for example. In the living room, the screen made out of individual elements comes from a Mercedes-Benz garage in Germany. And the collection of pendant lamps in the second house were found at the flea market of Saint-Ouen in Paris. In addition to their love of design, they also do like to make sure their guests are pampered. That's why you can choose between a sauna and a steam room, an indoor and an outdoor pool, a bar, a karaoke bar and club, a cinema and even a game room where you can play Japanese games. And then there's the wonderfully comfortable Bolia sofa where you can curl up and read a book. So even if it's raining cats and dogs—quite possible in this region—you'll still have a great time. It's like staying with friends. You're invited to have a drink in the evening in the kitchen, and for breakfast in the morning when they serve the 'tastiest bread in all of France', with eggs, yogurt and croissants. And a slice of watermelon for dessert. For fans of vintage cars, their baby blue Simca is available to drive around the area. There is plenty to explore. Maison Ceronne is also located in Le Perche, the nature park where you can walk, cycle and see deer freely leaping around. One of the best trips is going to Bellême where you will find nice interior design shops such as Studio 7 Avril, Chez les Voisins and Maison Close. And don't miss out on vintage stores La Maison Désinvolté and Chez Nous Campagne (with tearoom).
